Jackman Maine's ATV Trail System is soon to be recognized as a premier riding spot in the Northeast. We are located in a valley surrounded by mountains and 17 miles from the US/Quebec border crossing.

Come and enjoy some small town charm and hospitality. Jackman has many amenities such as, an ATV Clubhouse, accessible from the trails, on 50 acres w/ an oval dirt track and mud run. There is a resort, motels, cabins, campgrounds and rustic remote camps. We are home to an ATV Rentals location, a full service ATV Dealership (Polaris, Can Am, Arctic Cat, Yamaha), 5 restaurants w/alcohol (1 is BYOB, 1 is a pub w/entertainment, 1 is opening in June), a sports bar w/pool tables - 4 horseshoe pits and wide screen TV's, 3 pizza and grill places, 3 convenience stores w/fuel and alcohol, a grocery w/deli & bakery, a trading post, 2 self service laundromats an ice cream stand, 2 auto repair garages, a NAPA automotive store, 2 sporting goods locations and 2 hardware stores (1 w/canoe rentals and a powerwasher available on the weekends by donation, for that final cleaning as you head home).

Most lodging and services are connected to the in-town trail and are offering discounts to ATV Clubs, to support the sport, safety and a comradery among ATV Clubs, both near and far.

Our 300+ miles of maintained trail system runs through forest, over mountains, along streams & waterfalls, mud & rock sections and everywhere has a scenic vista that will warrant an eye opening verbal WOW. We have 3 full day rides to Rockwood, The Forks and Pittston Farms (set to open by July) with food and fuel, We also have a great 1/2 day ride to Bulldog Camps with food and fuel available w/a hike to up Owl's Head (intermediate trail, approx an hour and half up and back) you will remember this place as the first breath taking view coming into Jackman . Then you have Border Riders Sportsman's (ATV & Snowmobile) Club's maintained loop system for a few more day's worth of riding. You most likely will see moose, deer, foxes, beavers, coyotes (mostly immature pups), rabbits, hawks that fly down from trees along the trail, an occasional bald eagle and the backside of an occasional bear running across the trail. So cameras are a must !!!!!!!!!!!!!

We are now ready to host ATV Clubs to a full week of riding excitement and adventure. We can provide day's of riding within our own trail system as well as interconnecting with other trail systems through 7 area towns for day and overnight trips for a combined 700+ miles.

We have a direct trail to interconnect with Canada's ATV trails also.

We have ATV Rentals and a full service Polaris, Arctic Cat, Yamaha and Can Am dealership in the center of town, both accessible off the in-town trail.

Area businesses can provide guided and unguided, daily and overnight trips for as long as 4 days and 3 nights on the trail.

There is also Fishing, Canoeing, Air Tours, White Water Rafting and Hiking and a 9 hole Golf Course just to name a few of our local activities.

Border Riders Sportsman's Club will host your club to a home cooked style meal for your last night in town in exchange for a collective donation to our trail fund.

Trip Planning Page

- Club Discounts require a **minimum of 10 people upon arrival** to qualify for the special pricing along with a **3 night minimum**, so if someone cancels you will need to fill that spot.
- **If you have less than 10 people wanting to come, let me know as we are setting up a network to put you in touch with another out of state Club that has less than 10 people also. We are hoping this will help Clubs to come together for the common goal of a great riding experience, new people to share it with and best of all, do it at a great price.**
- Contact Maxx's ATV Rentals by e-mail kevin@maxxsatvrentals.com and include your Club Name, Contact Person, Contact Info, # of people and Trip arrival/departure Dates
- Once your info and trip dates are sent to participating businesses you will receive a confirmation e-mail.
- Once you receive the confirmation e-mail your group can book your lodging and any other activities desired. Your group can book lodging collectively or individually. See the enclosed ATV Club Discount List for lodging places i.e. Families in the group may want cabins and couples may want motels. Depending on the amount of people you may need to stay in different locations anyway. We have locations in town with trail access where you can all meet and ride out from.
- Once you arrive in town your contact person will check in at Maxx's ATV Rentals location (located in the center of town behind Boss Motel) and you will be given an ATV Club Discount Card with your club name and arrival/departure date for each member of the group. Show this card when you check in to your lodging or at any participating activity or services as described on the ATV Club Discount Page.
- We suggest you book activities such as Rafting and Air Tours when you book your lodging.

- **There is no registration reciprocity in Maine. The current out of state registration is \$69.00. The ATV Clubs throughout Maine are pushing for 3 day and 10 day registrations (same as snowmobile). The discounts we are offering will considerably offset this expense.**
- From there all you have to do is ride sober, stay on the marked trails and have a great time.

Necessary Items to Bring

- Over the calf waterproof boots
- Rain Gear (you can turn a corner on the trail and run into a cloudburst at any given time)
- Layers are good as mornings and evenings can be cool
- 2 sets of clothing for each day as we generally have good mud and water spots on the trails
- Tire repair kit as some trails are shale covered
- A reserve gas can for riding the outer loops and day trips to Rockwood and The Forks
